Bonn should be an international, cosmopolitan city where people from around 180 different countries enjoy living together. We want to actively shape this diversity. The SPD has always stood for solidarity, participation, and equal opportunities. We are the social voice of migrants and people with an immigration background in our city.

In the Integration Council of the City of Bonn, we are committed to supporting migrants and people with an immigration background in education, daycare centers and schools, with housing issues, and in the labor market, and to removing discriminatory barriers. We want to promote social interaction and intercultural coexistence in Bonn's districts, locally, in the neighborhood, in and with clubs, and to strengthen cohesion. We address the concerns of communities with an immigration background and will strengthen the space for political discussion and participation. We want to give a greater voice, especially to children and young people, senior citizens, and families with an immigrant background in Bonn. We want to create favorable conditions for successful integration in Bonn for people fleeing war and poverty or coming to us to work. As the SPD, we always take a clear stance against all forms of discrimination and racism; we stand together for democracy, diversity, and solidarity.

This is what we have achieved in the Integration Council:

- The city administration's services are now multilingual, so that people can access important information about the city of Bonn in their own language.
- There will be **memorial sites for the victims of right-wing extremism**, because Bonn opposes racism and right-wing extremism.
- The Muslim gravesites in the Nordfriedhof cemetery will remain. People should find their resting place close to their families.
- Improvement of the poor conditions in refugee shelters.
 No profit at the expense of refugees!
- We have decided: The support for Haus Vielinbusch must continue. The family and education center in Tannenbusch makes an important contribution to integration.

OUR GOALS AND DEMANDS IN THE BONN INTEGRATION COUNCIL:

- We will work to ensure that the Immigration Office has an online appointment booking portal, that conditions at the office improve overall, and that processing times are shortened.
- We want to promote and strengthen youth work and social counseling, as well as intercultural, community-based meeting places. We will support sports and intercultural clubs, as well as migrant self-organizations, in their efforts.
- We will introduce low-threshold, multilingual healthcare in the neighborhoods so that everyone has good care close to home.
- We want to improve the housing situation for families with a migration background and, where necessary, put pressure on housing associations that do not maintain apartments and buildings properly.
- We will promote integration by establishing an active urban welcoming culture.

 We will advocate for the interests of international students and researchers at the University of Bonn.
